The general policy about marching band is as follows: Unless you are involved in a JHS fall sport, or have a medical reason, you are required to be in marching band. Students with medical excuses or anyone involved in a JHS Fall sport (including cheerleading) can opt out of marching band and still participate in concert band. We have a few students choose this, but the vast majority have done both. Our policy is that sports people will not have to miss any of their sport practices or games-they just have to come to band any time they can. (This is obviously a lot of work, but lots of kids have done it!) ANY SUCH FALL SPORT/MEDICALLY-EXCUSED STUDENT WHO WANTS TO BE "CONCERT ONLY" HAS TO SIGN UP FOR BAND 1st SEMESTER-YOU WILL HAVE YOUR OWN "CONCERT-ONLY" CLASS DURING THE FIRST QUARTER. AFTER THAT YOU WILL ALL HAVE CONCERT BAND WITH EVERYONE ELSE.
